

Arrangements for contract management and reporting to accommodate the restructuring of NHS Wales

As set out in the Newsletter that was issued to all LHB contacts back in August 2009 we have prepared two reports aggregated to the new LHB level.

The reports are now available on the E Reporting system and through Payments Online (POL).

Report Title:

New monthly LHB Payment and Recharge Summary (found in finance section on E Reporting)

New monthly LHB Summary (found in contract management section on E Reporting)

Report Purpose:

To provide aggregated versions of the existing reports currently reported at the pre October LHB level.

To access the report through E Reporting users will need to select the new organisation code (new LHBs are prefixed with the number 7).

The relevant extract from the original newsletter is presented below for your information:

“The Payment and Recharge Summary and Contract Summary Reports will be published at the new LHB level every month (in addition to continuing to provide all reports at the current LHB level). The reports will be provided at LHB level only i.e. with no individual contract level data included. These reports will be made available to all POL/E Reporting users for the LHBs that comprise the respective new LHBs.

The current structure in place with the NHSDS reporting systems for 22 LHBs will remain until 30 June 2010 with all reports continuing to be provided at the current LHB level. This will continue through the year end 2009/10 reporting cycle (ending June 2010). No further reports at the current LHB level will be produced after June 2010

From July 2010 changes will be made to the POL and E Reporting systems to reflect the changes in the NHS Wales structure.

Thereafter all reports will be produced at this level. For completeness the reports for the period April to June 2010 will also be produced and published at this level during July 2010. “
