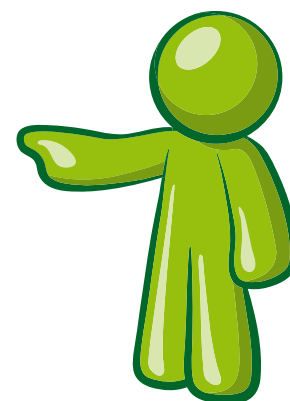


# NHS Pension Choice Exercise

## Which NHS Pension path will you take?



### The timetable for the delivery of Choice Packs as at October 2010

This timetable replaces the one sent to employees with their payslip last year. This may be subject to change as the NHS Pension Choice Exercise progresses.

The following members will receive a NHS Pension Choice Pack during the first period allocated to their Strategic Health Authority regardless of their age:

- Members working in a Direction Body and those members working in GP Practices

Where a NHS organisation has more than one office or location NHS Pension Choice Packs will be distributed by the Head Office. For example, National Blood Authority staff who are based around the

country. However their head office is in Newcastle. Therefore these members will receive their NHS Pension Choice Packs in line with the anticipated delivery dates for the North East.

**Dental Practitioner NHS Pension Choice Packs**

The Pensions and Dental divisions of the Business Services Authority are continuing to work together to collate the pensionable pay data required for General Dental Practitioners. Further information about the anticipated delivery of packs has yet to be agreed and will be publicised later.
