Request:

When someone is in receipt of temporary injury allowance and a pay rise to their full pay takes place, which they would have received if still on full pay, will the temporary injury allowance be recalculated so as to be 85% of their new pay?

Or will temporary injury allowance stay at the pre injury loss

Status: Complete

Response Date: 15/12/2010

The only instance, in which the Temporary Injury Allowance would be recalculated due to a pay rise, is if the pay award was backdated and this affected the pre-loss pay. Temporary Injury Allowance is always calculated using pre-loss pay.
