Could you please explain how your final pensionable pay is worked out when you leave the NHS 1995 section due to ill health? I would like to know if your pay is based on your final 365 paid days or based on your last final pensionable pay?

For your ease I confirm though that if you are a member of the 1995 section of the NHS Pension Scheme the final pensionable pay is based on the best of the last three years earnings. The final pensionable pay covers a period of 365 paid days counting back from the last day of membership.
