1. The total amount of money (both employer and employee contributions) paid into the NHS Pension scheme for the year 2009 to 2010.
2. The total amount of pension paid out to former employees in the same year 2009 to 2010.
3. The average pension per employee paid to former Consultant Medical Staff in 2009/10
4. The average pension per employee paid to other former Medical Staff in 2009/10
5. The average pension per employee paid to former Nursing and Midwifery staff in 2009/10 (include all nursing grades)
6. The average pension paid to former Admin and Clerical staff in 2009/10 (include managerial administrative staff, CEOs etc).
7. The average pension paid to former Professions Allied to Medicine in 2009/10 (Radiographers, O.T. etc.)
8. The average pension paid to former Ancillary staff in 2009/10 (Catering Domestic Maintenance staff etc).
9. The average pension per former employee paid in 2009/10.
