NHS Jobs is currently in the Private Beta stages of developing an all-new NHS Jobs service to replace the current version, which will fully launch in 2021. NHS Jobs are working alongside ten NHS Trusts who use NHS Jobs integrated with Electronic Staff Record (ESR) to trial the improved automation between the two systems.

NHS Jobs started working with Sheffield Children's NHS Foundation Trust in August 2020 as a Private Beta partner, to test out the ESR Integration functionality within the new NHS Jobs service. The partnership has been invaluable to NHS Jobs, as it has allowed essential testing of new service features to take place within a large NHS organisation, as well as allowing Sheffield to have their say in the shaping of the new NHS Jobs service.

Sheffield Children's NHS Foundation Trust is one of only three dedicated children's hospital Trusts in the UK.

As Private Beta partners, Sheffield Children's NHS Foundation Trust trialled the new shortlisting and invite to interview functionalities for their recruitment. Jude Stone, Associate Director of Transformation, described how the new features had a straightforward layout which was user friendly and easy to use. Jude also found the quantitative data that the features produced useful for their reporting.

Catherine Gilbert, ESR and Admin Officer at the Trust, also trialled the new vacancy creation features. Despite some initial teething problems which were quickly identified and fixed by the NHS Jobs team, Catherine said that she still found the feature simpler to use that that on the current service. Catherine described how the structure within the system looks a lot better making it easier to follow and therefore saving time.
