

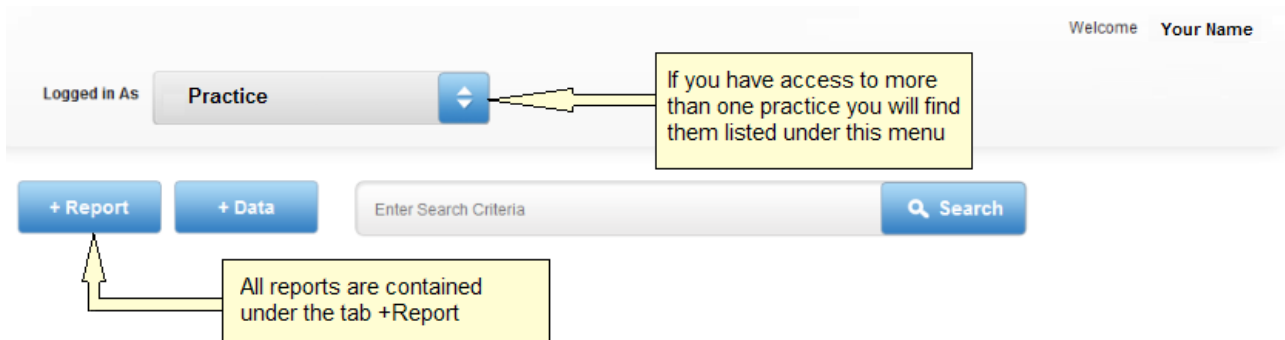
Information Services Portal

Useful features for practices

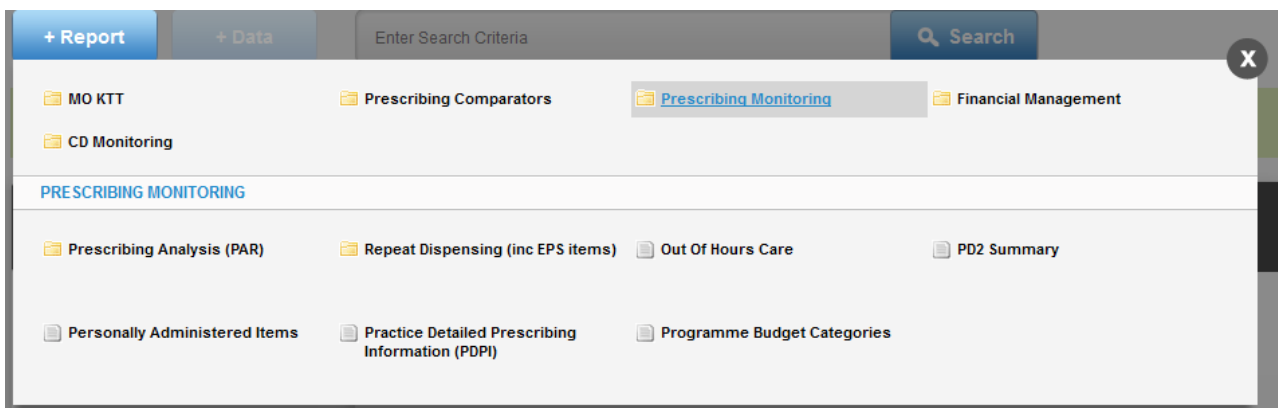


Data on the Information Services Portal is collated from the prescriptions submitted to the NHSBSA for processing by both practices and dispensing contractors in the community. All NHS organisations, including GP Practices, can register to use the portal. This guide provides a brief introduction to the features most commonly used by practice users. When you log into the Information Services Portal, you will see the home screen:



+Report contains all reports that are available to view split into sub-categories.



You will find the practice information under the sub-category **Prescribing Monitoring**. The **Personally Administered Items** and **Practice Detailed Prescribing Information** reports are two useful reports for practices which can be found here.

The report will open on the yearly overview when you access it and you can then drill down to individual item level (shown above).
