

Procedure Under Pads – Clinical Criteria		
Number	Criteria	Description
1	The packaging is clearly labelled and all required information is easily viewable.	The packaging has an easily identified description of correct use and size. All necessary detail such as lot numbers and manufacturer are easy to find
2	The packaging is of robust construction that contains the pads for storage and easy to open/access from full until all the contents have been used.	The packaging can be opened easily with bare hands and maintains the product in a usable condition until empty
3	The pads are easily dispensed individually	Individual pads can be taken from the packet with ease
4	Patient comfort with pad use	The texture of the absorbent surface of the pad when dry
5	The colour of the pad is not detrimental to its use	The colour of the absorbent surface does not hinder the observation of liquid
6	The pad absorbs liquid efficiently	The absorbency capacity of the pad
7	Patient comfort with pad use after liquid applied	The texture of the absorbent surface of the pad when contains fluid
8	Retention of liquid within the pad	The ability of the pad to not leak any liquid
9	The surface of the pad to remain dry when pad has been exposed to liquid	The surface layer to remain dry when pad absorbed liquid
10	Pad can be disposed safely	The pad can be rolled / folded without leakage
