

Are you applying for an NHS or Social Work Bursary?

You **must** provide correct information and genuine documents.

All reports of fraud are investigated and criminal, civil and disciplinary action considered.

If you are dishonest when completing your bursary application you may be committing a criminal offence under the Fraud Act 2006.

All these offences are indictable and may be heard at Crown Court:

- lying on your application
- not disclosing all information
- submitting documents that are not genuine



Fraud does not have to be successful to be prosecuted.

The maximum sentence is 10 years' imprisonment.
