Logging in

Before logging in, make sure you have activated your account by clicking on the link included in your registration email.

Payment information

The Information Services Portal contains payment information in the form of a copy of your Schedule of Payments and a Prescription Item Report. This provides transparent information for payments made on prescription items which have been dispensed in England.

You can access these by logging into the system and clicking on '+Report' then 'Payment Information', followed by the report you wish to view.
