
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

1. Getting Started

This will open the homepage.




2. Creating an analysis including Patient Count Information at Practice level and above



1 Select 'Analyses'.


2 Select 'Create Analysis'

The 'Subject Area' pane will appear.





3 Select your required Subject Area.

The 'Analysis Builder' will open.





Add the required fields and filters for Time Period, Organisation and Reporting Fields as in the example below.



- 4 Expand the 'Reporting Fields' section and add the 'Identified Patient Count (1 of 2)' column and the 'Patient Identified Count (2 of 2)' column to the analysis.


The analysis will now show the number of items and the patient count split between the patients which have been identified and those which have not.

3. Creating an analysis including Patient Count Information at Prescriber level



The 'Subject Area' pane will appear.



7 Select your required Subject Area.

The 'Analysis Builder' will open.

Add the required fields and filters for Time Period, Organisation and Reporting Fields as in the example below.



- 8 Expand the 'Reporting Fields' section and add the 'Prescriber Level Identified Patient Count (1 of 2)' column and the 'Patient Identified Count (2 of 2)' column to the analysis.

Please note user with National Level access will not have access to the 'Patient Identified Count (2 of 2)' column.

The analysis will now show the number of items and the patient count split between the patients which have been identified and those which have not at individual prescriber level.

Please note prescriber level Patient Count information will only be available for the organisations the user has registered under. If an organisation the user is not registered under is selected the system will return no results.
