

NHS Pensions - Contributions video transcript

Your NHS Pension Scheme contributions are automatically deducted from your pay every week or month depending on your pay arrangement.

The amount you contribute is based on your pensionable earnings (or whole time equivalent if you work part time).

There are currently seven contribution tiers ranging from 5% to 14.5%.

Did you know? Your employer contributes an extra 14.3% of your pay to help meet the cost of your pension benefits.
