Migration of reports from Information Services Portal to ePACT2

We have previously informed you that many of the reports which are currently accessed through the Information Services Portal (ISP) will be migrating to ePACT2. The migration will take place in two phases and the first phase will take place on 21 December 2018 when the following suites of reports will migrate:

- MO KTT

The MO KTT reports have been launched in Beta to enable users to experience the 'look and feel' of the reports and will give users the opportunity to provide feedback.

From this date access to these reports will be removed from ISP.

Phase 2 will be completed mid-January 2019.

On 21 December 2018 a new portal to host the reports which are currently accessed by guest users of the Information Services Portal is launched.
