


How to reset your NHS Jobs password.

Step 1: Enter your email address.

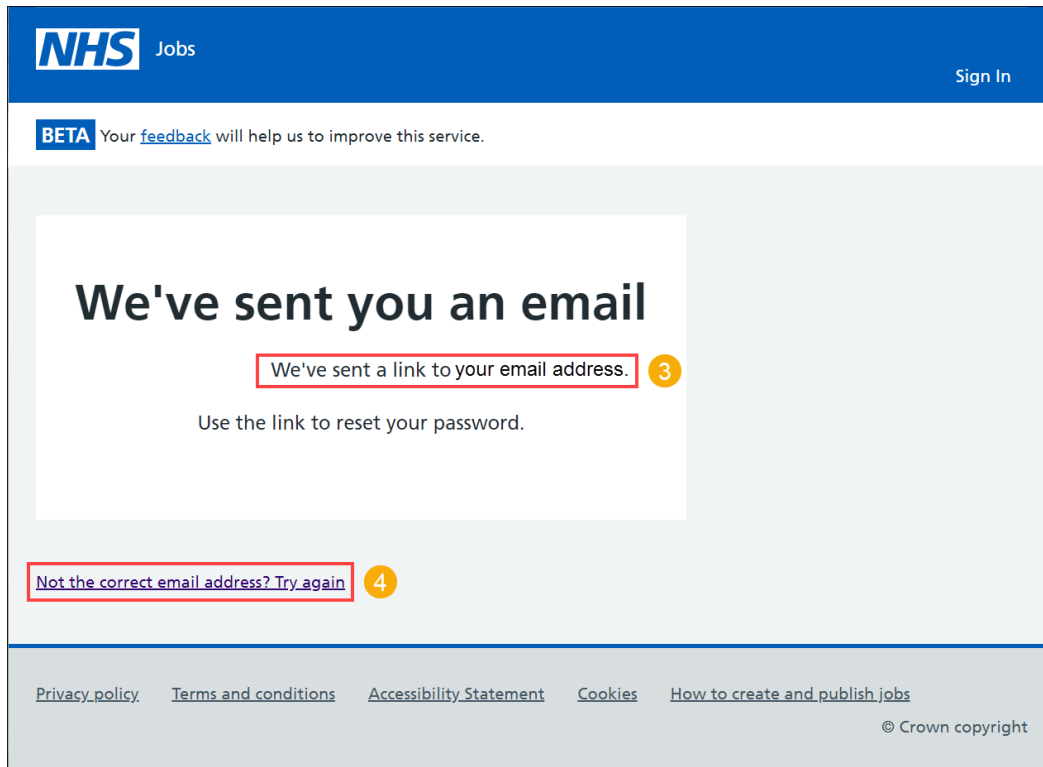

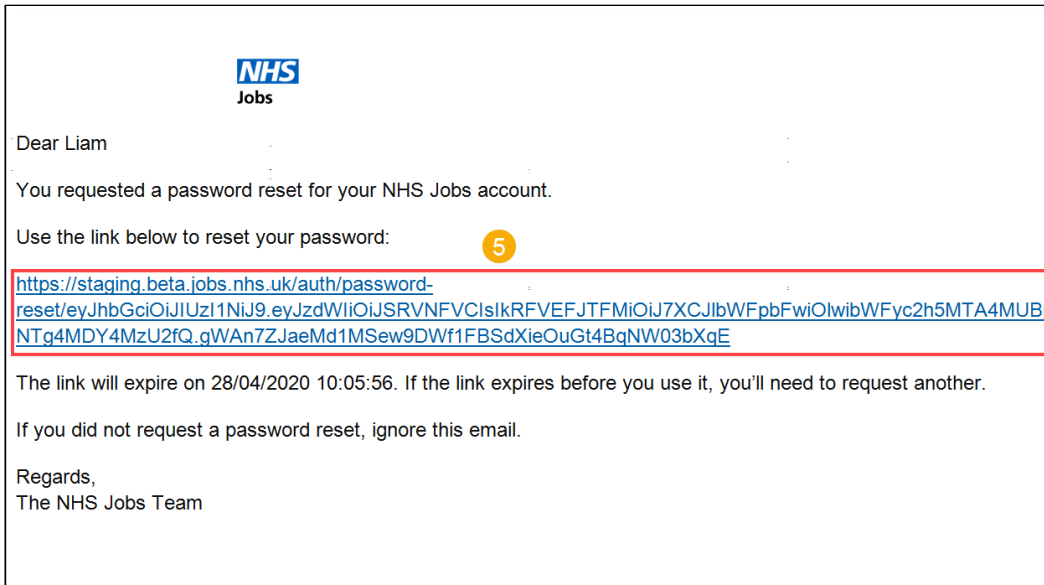

Step 3: A links sent to your email address.

Step 4: Select the Try again link if the email address entered is incorrect (Optional).



Step 5: You'll receive an email with a link to reset your password. Select the password reset link to create a new password. You must use the password link before the date and time of expiry.




Step 6: Read the password guidance. Your password must contain:

- a. a number
- b. uppercase and lowercase letters
- c. no less than 12 characters

Step 7: Enter your new password in the boxes and they must match.

Step 8: Select the **Continue** button to confirm your password reset.
