1	Content update on qualifications and training pages.	The content for qualifications and training has been improved, to make it easier to understand.	Applicants will have a clearer understanding of what information is required in these sections.
2	Content improvements to the 'Are you sure you want to save this application?' page.	Additional content added to this page to clarify to applicants what information will be saved.	Applicants know exactly what information will be saved for the next time they want to apply for a job.
3	Save application pause page.	A new pause page has been added to the start of the application to say applicants are able to save their information, and what they can save.	Applicants are aware at the start of applying for a job that they can save their information, once completed.
4	Content improvements to the save application confirmation page.	Content improvements to the save application page.	Clearer information for applicants to know that their application has sent, as well as clearer options for how to move on.
5	Save option removed from CV application.	The option to save an application has been removed from when completing a CV.	This prevents any previous online application information being overwritten with blank details.  The areas affected were:  - Qualifications - Training - Job history
6	Bug fix - Welsh Language	Bug fix to ensure if a user selects to view in Welsh, they are not reverted back to English when they click on to the next page.	The user's language preference is saved when using the service.
7	Latest updates - known issues	Known issue information added to the applicant hub.  - Unable to see applications in shortlist and invite to interview status.  - System timeout prompt not refreshing session when more time requested.	Applicants are aware of current issues in the service and advice for how to work around the issues until resolved.
