| 1 | Update the Area of work list. | Area of work list updated to add, amend and remove options for employers when creating their job. | The 'Area of work' list in NHS Jobs and Jobsite will match, reducing application programming interface (API) failures. |
| 2 | Deactivate employer account. | The ability for the service team to flag employer accounts on the database. This disables the account and prevents users logging in. | Employers can request for specific user accounts to be deactivated to prevent access to those who may no longer be part of an organisation. |

| 3 | Jobsite publishing - Allow publishing for previously failed vacancies that are updated. | The API between NHS Jobs and Jobsite has been updated to resend vacancies to the current service when an employer edits or closes a job. | If Jobsite rejects a job for any reason, employers can make changes and the job will resend. This reduces the need for the job to be created again on the current service. Employers can now add prohibited wording and URL's within a job advert due to an update by Jobsite. |
