2	Continuous improvement	<p>Various improvements to the service, including:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Introducing a simplified view of the 'Your job applications' page. Applicants can now see their applications, the job details and what stage they are in, at a glance.</li> <li>- If an applicant has a large volume of applications, these are now shown 10 per page.</li> <li>- The Applicant Hub is accessible on smaller device screens.</li> <li>- Character counts added to various sections of the application form, to make it more visible to applicants how much content they are able to add.</li> <li>- Additional Welsh translations added to the service for applicants who prefer to view the service in Welsh.</li> </ul>
