

## Clinical Data Set validation rules from 1 April 2022 England

From 1 April 2022, stricter validation rules will be applied to FP17 activity submissions. From this date, each treatment band on an FP17 must have at least one Clinical Data Set (CDS) item that is appropriate to the treatment band claimed.

To apply these stricter rules, each of the FP17 CDS items will be allocated a new “CDS treatment band”.

The CDS treatment band values will be 0, 1, 2 or 3 as follows:

<b>Permitted Claims</b>	<p>Allowed on any claim, including Charge Exempt and Domiciliary Visits/Sedation only claims</p> <p>Urgent claims cannot consist solely of these items, otherwise the claim will fail with error code 129 (see below)</p>	<p>Allowed on Band 1, 2, 3, Reg 11 or Urgent only otherwise the claim will fail with error code 130</p> <p>There must be at least one of these codes present if Band 1 is claimed, otherwise the claim will fail with error code 129 (see below)</p>	<p>Allowed on Band 2, 3, Reg 11 or Urgent only otherwise the claim will fail with error code 130</p> <p>There must be at least one of these codes present if Band 2 is claimed, otherwise the claim will fail with error code 129 (see below)</p>	<p>Allowed on Band 3 or Reg 11 only otherwise the claim will fail with error code 130</p> <p>There must be at least one of these codes present if Band 3 is claimed, otherwise the claim will fail with error code 129 (see below)</p>

If a claim fails one of the above checks it will result in one of the following two new error codes:

- **Error code 129** - no treatment item which matches the band claimed is present on the claim – *please note that for a temporary period Error code 129 has been replaced by the comment code 011 - No treatment to justify band*
- **Error code 130** - treatment item claimed for a higher band than that is on the claim – *please note that for a temporary period Error code 130 has been replaced by the comment code 012 - Treatment entered higher than band*

The below table provides the details of the CDS treatment band allocated to each CDS item and indicates the treatment code too.

Please note that these checks will only take place on claims submitted with a Date of Acceptance of 01/04/22 or later.

More Specific Validation of Treatment

If Incomplete Treatment (9164) is present on a claim the above checks will not be carried out.

The below tables indicate the CDS items required when either a Regulation 11 or free repair/replacement claim is submitted.

If a claim fails the above checks, then **error code 132** will be generated (Treatment claimed does not accord with Reg 11 Replacement) – *please note that for a temporary period Error code 132 has been replaced by the comment code 013 Reg 11 claim without appliance.*

If a claim fails the above checks, then **error code 133** will be generated (Treatment claimed does not accord with treatments associated with Free Repair/Replacement) – *please note that for a temporary period Error code 133 has been replaced by the comment code 014 Free Repair without repair/replaceable item*
