

**COVID-19 Vaccination Service Site Sign-up Process Clarifications Log: 30 July**  
**– 4 September 2024**

1. I was hoping to find out if I am able to register my interest to provide the COVID-19 vaccine on the NHS.

I run a private vaccination clinic but do receive requests from patients wanting their vaccine and are within the NHS eligible cohort.

I'm not sure if I am too late to register my interest. Your help and guidance will be greatly appreciated.

*Any provider is able to complete a Response Document as long as they meet the Minimum Requirements outlined [here](#). As detailed in the Site Sign-Up Process, providers are able to provide submissions throughout the contractual period. Any Potential Supplier that misses the Interim Response Deadline will not be onboarded for that specified campaign and will only be onboarded for the following campaign. Therefore, any provider which submits a Response Document at this time will not be onboarded until the next campaign (at the earliest Spring 2025).*
