

Reminder: virtual classroom training is now live

From September, we're offering NHS Jobs training sessions using our brand-new virtual classroom. These sessions are designed to include:

- 'Show me' a demonstration from a trainer
- 'Try me' an opportunity to do it yourself
- 'Test me' to check your knowledge and skills

We plan on delivering two sessions per week - one on a Wednesday morning and one on a Thursday afternoon.

- · managing your organisation's account, documents and templates
- creating, publishing and managing job listings
- scoring applications and shortlisting applicants
- inviting applicants to interview and managing schedules
- · making and managing applicant job offers
- · completing applicant pre-employment checks
- · issuing and managing applicant contracts
- ending or continuing a recruitment process

Amplify the NHS Pension Scheme in your adverts

Many NHS Jobs adverts miss a simple, but powerful, draw for potential applicants - the NHS Pension Scheme.

If you are an NHS organisation enrolled in the Scheme, highlighting this government-backed benefit can make your roles stand out and appeal to applicants who value long-term financial security.

For starters, employers can ensure that their job adverts mention the NHS Pension Scheme. They can also include concise information in the job overview about Scheme benefits, including:

- a pension payable for life, fully guaranteed by the government with employer contributions of 23.7%
- options for flexible retirement
- · an optional one-off lump sum when you retire
- an ill health retirement pension, should you become too ill to work
- death benefits, including a lump sum and a pension for partners and dependent children
- ways to increase the value of your NHS pension
